“Licensed United States federal inspectors were given 4 hours of training on the visual clues of potential damage by *Aspergillus* in kernels in graded samples of a 1-ton lot of nuts.”
was changed to
“In the USA, after 3–4 hours of training on visual signs of contamination with *Aspergillus*, people with no prior experience were asked to visually sort samples of groundnuts that had already been classified according to their quality (sound, damaged, intermediate) by federal inspectors according to the official grading procedure.”
